## **Product Description**

6318B resin is hexene comonomer based Linear Low Density Polyethylene grade designed to provide easy processability and specially formulated for optimum thermal stability at high processing temperatures used during production of Cast films. Films produced using this resin gives excellent optical properties, toughness, puncture resistance and tear strength.

## **Typical Applications**

It is recommended for pellet wrap (pre-stretch), high performance draw down films and other general purpose applications where high strength is required.

# **Processing Conditions**

Typical processing conditions for 6318B are:

Melt temperature: 265 - 300°C

Chill roll temperature: 20°C

## Storage and Handling

Polyethylene resin should be stored in a manner to prevent a direct exposure to sunlight and/or heat. The storage area should also be dry and preferably don't exceed 50°C. SABIC would not give warranty to bad storage conditions which may lead to quality deterioration such as color change, bad smell and inadequate product performance. It is advisable to process PE resin within 6 months after delivery.

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
